Arthur "Art" Walter Hettman passed away in Newport Oregon on Friday June 25 at the age of 90.

He was born on June 16, 1920 in Beavercreek, Oregon to Henry and Lottie Hettman. He attended school at the Schubel Grade school. He served honorably in the United States Navy during WWII, seeing action on the island of Saipan in the Pacific theater. On August 14, 1943, he married Violet Bittner, in Beavercreek, Or. Following the war, he returned to Oregon and worked as a logger, ultimately retiring from B&T Logging in 1985. Art enjoyed fishing, clamming and trapping crawdads, gardening and spending time with family and friends. Art was a great cook who was famous for his fried chicken. He was a member of the Beavercreek United Church of Christ and a member of the Woodworkers Union.

Violet passed away in January of this year after over 66 years of marriage. Art is survived by his family, Gary and Marsha Hettman of Toledo, Oregon; Marilyn and Doug Kemp of Newport, Oregon; Greg and Shelley Hettman of Oregon City, Oregon, 9 grandchildren and 9 great grandchildren.
