She was the youngest of 10 children; Gayell Brown, Orvel Brown, Oma Pearl Brown, John Brown, Cletus Lemuel Brown, Kenneth Brown, Violet Brown, Bessy Viola Brown, and Delora Brown, her twin sister.

Dorothy grew up and graduated from high school in Plummer, Idaho. She married Lawrence Richard Fowler on July 17, 1937, and in 1941 they moved to Little Rock, Arkansas to spend time with Larry's family. In the spring of 1943 they moved to Portland, Oregon, eventually settling in North Portland. In 1958 they move to Southeast Portland, and in 1966 they moved to a home with property near Oregon City.

Dorothy and her husband Larry had two children, Wanda and Deloris. Dorothy enjoyed Gardening at home, fishing and hunting with her immediate family, as well as spending time on the beach in Lincoln City, OR with family and friends. From the 60's to the late 80's they raised and trained racehorses, and they had a number of winning entries over the years. Dorothy was a devoted

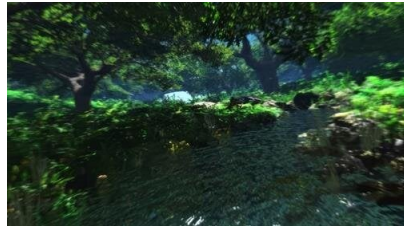
