At CHS she worked in Instructional Services and the Athletic Director's office, after which she followed one of the athletic directors to the North Clackamas School District athletic office. She loved her "kids" at CHS – many of whom

called her “Mom.”

She enjoyed sporting events of all kinds. She and Bob fell in love with the Atlanta Braves, and after they both retired, they spent time visiting different cities in the U.S. to watch the Braves play ball and get to know the country. For years, they spent a week in September in Pendleton, Oregon attending Professional Bull Riding and the Pendleton Roundup.

Haroldene was predeceased by her husband in 2007, and her son Ron Hartwig in 2018. She is survived by son Mike Hartwig (Leslie), Ron’s widow Judy Hartwig, her “CHS” son Russ Ahsing (Tammy), eight grandchildren, their spouses and eight great-grandchildren.

She loved us all – and all who ever met and knew her loved her and will miss her.
