Harry Leroy Montgomery, age 91, of Oregon City, died May 19th, 2017 at home of natural causes. Harry was born December 5, 1925 in Stratton, Colorado to William and Ruth Montgomery. Harry captained the 1943 Newberg state champion football team. He served in WWII in the Vancouver shipyard and later as a seaman in the Merchant Marines.
