Mom was a strong and powerful individual, very independant, she had to overcome so many obsticles in her life beginning from a young a child. Her family often made ends meet by following the depression crowd and picking seasonal fruit for money and food to survive.

Some of Moms favorite years were her High School years where she was popular and always filled her days with fun and friends. She was athletic, she played softball and participated in Track & Field.

Mom married young, just out of High Schiool, at age 18 and was a mother at age 19, then 20, then 22, then 23 and on and on and on having a total of 8 Children by the age of 32. Life with so many children was difficult as she raised her children basically on her own. She lost her own mother in 1967 at age 52 in a tragic auto accident.

Mom gave up her hopes and dreams of being a professional and successful woman to raise her children and hold steady as a homemaker. The road was a rocky one with many hills to climb and mountains to overcome but Mom never waivered. Her strength and uncommon courage held our family of 8 kids and her together through every storm and monstrous cloud thrown at us.

Mom was extremely talented in many ways, one of her greatest talents was her crafting ability and beautiful creativity. Mom created some of the most stunning crafts you ever laid eyes on. Many of her fine crafts were sold at craft fairs to travelers and now reside in many areas around the world as far away as Australia.

Mom remarried in 1972 to a wonderful man named Walt. He took us all in and made us safe. Walt took on a struggling family of eight kids, gave Mom her first new home and property. Walt was a giant of a man to join our family. Walt passed away in 2003 and Mom has been very independant every since.

For several years now Mom has spent a great deal of her time working on her family genealogy. It was a massive undertaking but she would get so thrilled each time when she discovered that she was kin to a king or famous person and that she had relatives who arrived on the Mayflower and even relatives who ruled in castles hundreds of years ago across the seas. Mom has done a wonderous job in being protective guardian of family photos, many of them from the late 1800's and early 1900's. A new family photo and genealogy guardian has been knighted and the cherished treasure shall be lovingly preserved. A dedicated electronic family library is now is process and will be shared to all family upon its completion.

Mom overcame 2 types of cancer at the age of 32, discovered with the birth of her youngest son Kelly. Mom was just celebrating 40 years cancer free when
