Michael Byron Baker, 71, passed away on December 6th, 2023, in Oregon City, OR surrounded by his wife and children after a long battle with cancer.

Michael was born on September 9th, 1952 in Portland, OR, to Byron Baker and Dorothy Baker. Michael graduated from Gresham High in 1970 and went on to earn an Associate degree from Mount Hood Community College in 1972. He served in the United States Navy from 1972-1978. After completing the Machinist Mate Second Class at the Navy Nuclear Power school. Then he served on the USS Halibut SSN-587. Upon leaving the Navy he started his career as an Electrician and Fire Protection Engineering Technician and trainer. Michael spent the latter part of his career presenting fire protection, fire code, and building code seminars across the USA and Canada. Ending his career at Clackamas Community College as an Oregon Electrical Apprenticeship Teacher and with Jet Industries as a trainer.

Michael married Cynthia Baker on September 1st, 1996 in Gladstone OR. The couple shared their six children from their previous marriages; Adam Baker, Andrew Baker, Adrian Baker, Sarah Rollins, Mike Baker, and Samantha Kretschmer. 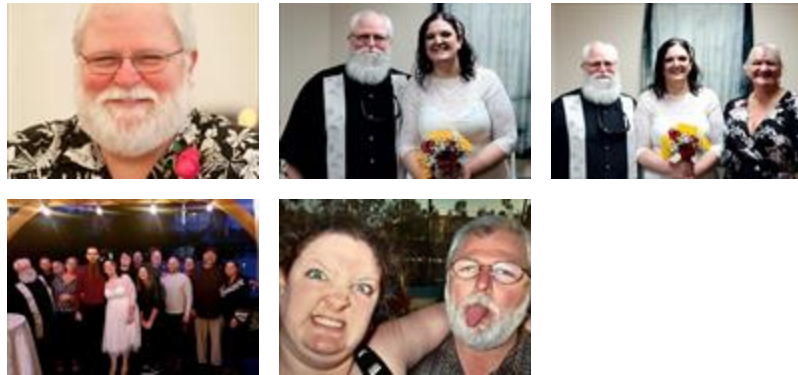
