Her favorite holiday was Christmas , the gifts overflowed the room ,as it turned out it was the kids favorite Holiday also . She has been blessed with 6 Great Grandchildren she adored . She passed away at home peacefully surrounded by alot of Love . Her proudest achievement was when her and her sister Barbara Swan entered a contest to name the park that was built on the parcel of property that she sold to the city .
