Terry Lee Voss, died peacefully at the home he built in Oregon City on July 5, 2023 following a brief and quiet battle with cancer. Born July 16, 1946 to Avis Tilbury and Lawrence Voss, Terry was in the middle of the pack of six boys. He was preceded in death by his parents, his brothers, Rick and Randy Boehnen, and his son, Derek Voss. He is survived by his wife of 41 years, Renee, their daughter, Rebecca Voss, former spouses, Sandy Lutz and Marie Gould Voss, children (with Sandy), Kelly Pearce, Terry V. 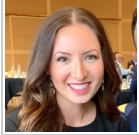

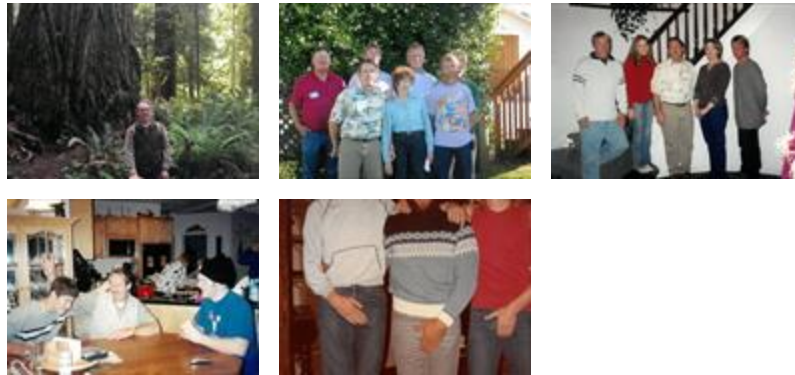

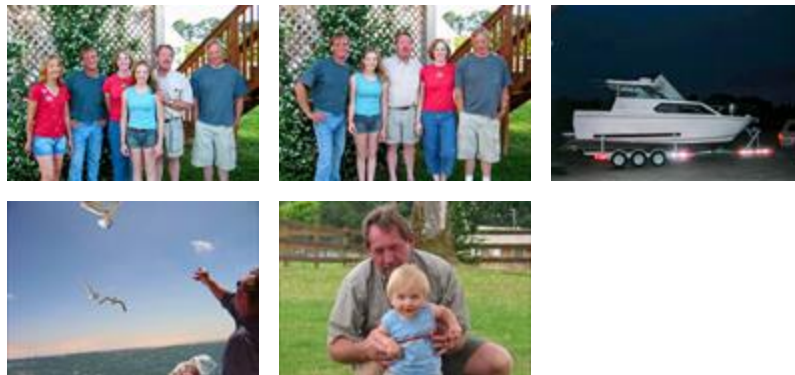
