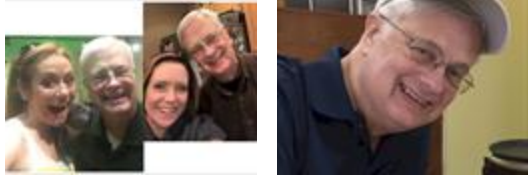
He is survived by brothers Robert, David, and Richard Pine; sister Mary
